| Why does God say "no"? 1. He things we don't. Heb. 4:13a – "Nothing is all creation is hidden from God's sight." Prov. 2:8 – "He guards the course of the just and protects the way of His faithful ones." |
| 2. His Kingdom is more important than ours. Isa. 55:8,9 – God's ways higher than our ways. Heb. 11:39,40 – "none of them received what had been promised. God had planned something better for us" |
| 3. His is broader than ours. Isa. 46:10 – "My purpose will stand." Behind every problem there is a – but not necessarily an explanation! |
| Do I trust God, even when I don't understand? Is God worthy of my praise, even when nothin seems to be going right? If He never answers another prayer for me, is His sacrifice on the cross for my sins enough for me? YES!!! |
