1. This is a prayer for _____ – His Kingdom coming into our lives as we move from the kingdom of darkness into the kingdom of “His dear Son” – Col. 1:13,14
So this is a prayer for your unsaved loved ones. Are you praying for anyone’s salvation?

2. _____ kingdom – that’s how they understood it – Acts 1:6 – “Lord, are you at this time going to restore the Kingdom to Israel?”
This is a prayer for Christ to come back to earth and set us His Kingdom! Rev. 22:20

3. Living by Kingdom principles – Matt. 5:3 – Blessed are the poor in spirit, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven”.
In the Sermon on Mt. Jesus lays out the principles of the Kingdom – “you have heard that it was said – BUT I SAY TO YOU.....” Phil. 3:20 – “our citizenship is in heaven”“ - Help me live as a citizen of your Kingdom”
