Practical suggestions:

***Have a place to pray.

***What do you do while you're waiting? What do you do with the gaps of your life? Waste them? Or pray them? Use those moments to maintain your connection to God.

***Use the newspaper and news as a prayer guide. Pray through it. Are you reading about the election, or are you praying about it?

***Pray through your calendar; your appointments.

***As you pray the pattern of the Lord's Prayer – LISTEN while you pray. When you pray, “YOUR kingdom come” – listen to what He's saying to you. When you put on the armor of God - LISTEN for the Truth.
