Luke 18:1 – the two options: or give up!
Widow: poor, hopeless, no position, no connection
Judge: No reverence for God; doesn't care about people
Us (we are like the widow): Phil. 4:19; Ps. 39:7; Zech. 2:8; Rom. 8:15 We have connections!
God is like the judge: Ps. 34:8; Ps. 103:8,10,11; Isa. 49:16
God is interested in your prayers – and! He invites us to pray: Phil. 4:6; Ps. 62:8
v. 8 – "Will He find faith on the earth?" (Luke 21:34-36) Luke 11
