PRAYER – Luke 18; Luke 11 – PERSISTENCE

Luke 18:1 – the two options: \_\_\_\_\_ or give up!

Widow: poor, hopeless, no position, no connection

Judge: No reverence for God; doesn't care about people

Us (we are \_\_\_\_\_ like the widow): Phil. 4:19; Ps. 39:7; Zech. 2:8; Rom. 8:15  
We have \_\_\_\_\_ connections!

God is \_\_\_\_\_ like the judge: Ps. 34:8; Ps. 103:8,10,11; Isa. 49:16

God is interested in your prayers – and \_\_\_\_\_!  
He invites us to pray: Phil. 4:6; Ps. 62:8

v. 8 – “Will He find faith on the earth?” (Luke 21:34-36)

Luke 11

Three sections of The Lord's Prayer:

God, You're \_\_\_\_\_  
Your \_\_\_\_\_ over mine  
Here's what I \_\_\_\_\_

God is not bothered by my persistence – He's \_\_\_\_\_ by it!

Why is persistence necessary?
