Heb. 10:25 - "Let us not give up meeting togetherbut let us encourage one another - and all the more as you see the Day approaching."

III. ONCE, IT CAN FULFILL ITS RIGHTFUL PURPOSE  A. It has to be the house of "Judgment begins at the house of God" - I Peter 4:17
B. Then it can be the house of prayer - "If I regard iniquity in my heart, the Lord will not hear me" - Ps. 66:18
C. And then it becomes the house of Matt. 21:14
IV ARE THE TEMPLE! - I Cor. 3:16,17 - "Don't you know that you yourselves are God's temple and that God's Spirit lives in you?for God's temple is sacred, and you are that temple."
