Two characters from Palm Sunday we should emulate.

I. THE \_\_\_\_\_ – LIKE THE DONKEY’S OWNER, I HAVE SOMETHING GOD CAN \_\_\_\_\_

Each of us has a donkey. Each of us have some things in our life if given back to God would help carry Jesus to another place.

II. THE \_\_\_\_\_ – LIKE THE DONKEY, I CAN CARRY \_\_\_\_\_ INTO MY WORLD

The donkey was a Christ-bearer, or a Christopher. Today is an opportunity to take the name Christopher as our own. By doing so, we commit to bearing Christ to the world.
