## SERMON NOTES

Matt. 13:3-9; 18-23 (Mark 4:1-8; 14-20)
PRAYER: LEARNING TO LISTEN TO GOD

FIRST SOIL: STONY PATH - v. 4, 19
It represents a $\qquad$ , hard heart and mind.

Listening principle: Cultivate an $\qquad$ heart and mind.

SECOND SOIL: SHALLOW GROUND - ROCKY PLACES - v. 5, 20,21 It represents a $\qquad$ , superficial heart and mind

Listening principle: Take time to $\qquad$ , really listen.

THIRD SOIL: THORNY GROUND - v. 7, 22
It represents a preoccupied, $\qquad$ heart and mind

Christ defines the thorns in v. 22:

1. Worries of this life - is a business word; means distractions and worries
2. Deceitfulness of wealth - wealth promises more than it can deliver - aren't we all seeing that right now
3. Mark 4:19 - Mark's account of this parable adds: "Desire for other things"

Listening principle: eliminate the $\qquad$ .

FOURTH SOIL: GOOD GROUND - V. 8, 23
Matt. 13:23 - "hears and understands"
Mark 4:20 - "hear and accept it"
Luke 8:15 - "hear the word, retain it, and by persevering produce a crop."
It represents a fruitful, $\qquad$ heart and mind.

Listening principle: $\qquad$ what you hear from God.

But when you hear, how do you know it's from God?
Is it $\qquad$ ? What you hear from God will NEVER contradict the Bible.

Is it $\qquad$ ? (ethical, moral) "It's never right to do wrong, even to get a chance to do right."

Is it Providential? (open doors - but sometimes you have more than one!)
Is it confirmed? - multitude of counselors - check it out!
Do I have the $\qquad$ of God? Col. 3:15

What if I'm not sure? If you can't get a clear answer, make sure you're in God's will now. If so, stay in God's will until He gives you the word to make a change.
