Mark 2:1 “Home” is the place of routine, ordinary life – commonplace, everyday life. Capernaum – “HOME” - was a diverse place

Mark 3:1-6

Matt. 11:20, 23-24 - Then He began to rebuke the cities in which most of His mighty works had been done, because they did not repent:²³ And you, Capernaum, who are exalted to heaven, will be brought down to Hades; for if the mighty works which were done in you had been done in Sodom, it would have remained until this day.²⁴ But I say to you that it shall be more tolerable for the land of Sodom in the day of judgment than for you.”

We get so involved in the routines of life that we miss the miracles all around us. Christ wants to touch every part of our lives - to permeate everything we do.
