## "HOW TO LEAVE A GODLY LEGACY" - ENOCH Gen. 5:21-24; Heb. 11:5,6; Jude 14,15

Gen. 5:21-24 - <sup>21</sup> When Enoch had lived 65 years, he became the father of Methuselah.<sup>22</sup> After he became the father of Methuselah, Enoch walked faithfully with God 300 years and had other sons and daughters. <sup>23</sup> Altogether, Enoch lived a total of 365 years. <sup>24</sup> Enoch walked faithfully with God; then he was no more, because God took him away.
