Some suggest that the word "harm" in v. 13 can mean " to your soul or spirit". Rom. 8:31 – "If God is for us, who can be against us."
A. Remember, you are if you suffer for Christ. (3:14,17) cf. Matt. 5:10; I Peter 4:14 – 16: We will be better prepared to handle suffering for our faith if we remember that suffering for Christ brings ! So don't be !
B. Set apart Christ as (3:14-15) "Lord, today You are the Lord of my life. I set you on the throne of my life. Not my will, but Yours, be done."
C. Keep a clear conscience (3:16)
D. Remember example (3:18)
II. BE PREPARED TO GIVE AN When Peter uses the word "hope", he's referring primarily to the hope we have ultimately in the of Christ.
A. The Biblical philosophy of evangelism FRANgelism (Elmer Towns) In Acts it talks about going "house to house". That word is "oikos" and included, relatives, business and social associates, and neighbors.

 B. Be understandable and believable! 1) gentleness – a mild disposition 2) respect – an attitude toward others that flows from our attitude toward God
