### “GODOLOGY” – THINKING RIGHT THOUGHTS ABOUT GOD

Knowing God involves our mind, emotions, and will.

“Godology” – words about \_\_\_\_\_

A. W. Tozer: “What comes into our minds when we think about God is the most important thing about us.”

What we think about God will determine how we \_\_\_\_\_.

The characteristics of God are called Attributes. “Anything that God has revealed about Himself is an Attribute of God.”

1. Self-existent and Self-sufficient – Acts 17:24,25 – “The God who made the world and everything in it is the Lord of heaven and earth and does not live in temples built by human hands. And he is not served by human hands, as if he needed anything. Rather, he himself gives everyone life and breath and everything else.”

He is not dependent on others. He is \_\_\_\_\_ in Himself. Nothing can be \_\_\_\_\_ to or \_\_\_\_\_ from Him.

God has a VOLUNTARY relationship with us – but He doesn’t \_\_\_\_\_ us to complete Himself. “He needs no one, but when faith is present He works through anyone.”
