Matt. 13:24-30; 36-43 – WHEAT OR WEEDS?

The seed in this parable is \_\_\_\_\_.

"bearded darnel" - "tares/weeds" In their early stages it was impossible to tell tares from wheat.

At harvest-time, the harvesters will harvest the weeds and they will be burned, and the wheat will be taken to the Father's house!

1. God has you \_\_\_\_\_ He wants you!

2. There is a hostile power at work in the world. The \_\_\_\_\_ is sowing people, too.  
(Maybe right next to where God has planted you!)

Acts 20:29,30 – “Even from your own number men will arise and distort the truth...”

3. We can't always immediately tell wheat from \_\_\_\_\_.

5. We must make sure we're true wheat, because judgment IS coming.

II Cor. 13:5 – written to church members: “Examine yourselves to see whether you are in the faith; test yourself.”
