### God Never Changes – He is Immutable

I Sam. 15:29 - He Who is the Glory of Israel does not lie or change His mind; for He is not a human being, that He should change His mind.”

Ps. 102:27 - But You remain the same, and Your years will never end.

Malachi 3:6 - I the LORD do not change. So you, the descendants of Jacob, are not destroyed.

Heb. 13:8 - Jesus Christ is the same yesterday and today and forever.

Heb. 1:12 - But You remain the same, and Your years will never end.

James 1:17 Every good and perfect gift is from above, coming down from the Father of the heavenly lights, who does not change like shifting shadows.

Immutability means God does not change in his basic \_\_\_\_\_. He never \_\_\_\_\_ from Himself. He always is what He is.

Changeless in His \_\_\_\_\_, Nature, Attributes

Changeless in His \_\_\_\_\_ – Heb. 6:17,18

Changeless in His \_\_\_\_\_ – Matt. 28:19,20

God’s \_\_\_\_\_ does not change. – Matt. 24:35

God’s \_\_\_\_\_ do not change
