The “omnis” of God: omnipresent – everywhere present at the same time; omnipotent – has all power
omniscience – knows everything. *God is with me. God is able. God knows best.*

Limitations:

Absurd or self-contradictory things – a square circle; a sensitive stone

Things contrary to His nature (remember, He never changes) – He can’t lie; love sin; etc.

He never crosses the free moral agency of man.
