PROV. 30:4 – GOD, THE CREATOR, CAN BE TRUSTED WITH MY LIFE!

PROV. 30:4 – “Who has gone up to heaven and come down? Whose hands have gathered up the wind? Who has wrapped up the waters in a cloak? Who has established all the ends of the earth? What is His name, and what is the name of His son? Surely you know!”

Job 38:4 - 11 - “Where were you when I laid the earth’s foundation? Tell me, if you understand. <sup>5</sup> Who marked off its dimensions? Surely you know! Who stretched a measuring line across it? <sup>6</sup> On what were its footings set, or who laid its cornerstone—<sup>7</sup> while the morning stars sang together and all the angels shouted for joy? <sup>8</sup> “Who shut up the sea behind doors when it burst forth from the womb, <sup>9</sup> when I made the clouds its garment and wrapped it in thick darkness, <sup>10</sup> when I fixed limits for it and set its doors and bars in place, <sup>11</sup> when I said, ‘This far you may come and no farther; here is where your proud waves halt?’”

Gen. 1:1 – “In the beginning, God created the heavens and the earth.”

### 1. WHAT DOES THE LANGUAGE OF GEN. 1 TEACH US?

A. God created the world from \_\_\_\_\_

Heb. 11:3 – “By faith (No, we won’t be able to fully understand it – it ultimately is a faith issue, but faith is based on facts) we understand that the universe was formed at God’s command, so that what is seen was not made out of what was visible.”

B. God created the world in six \_\_\_\_\_-hour days.

Moses used the Hebrew word *yôm* for 'day'. In every case throughout the Bible, *yôm* used in this way always refers to a normal 24-hour day. Moses used the word “yom” with a numerical adjective (first, second, etc.) 119 times, and it is used 357 times outside of the Books of Moses, and it ALWAYS means a 24-hour day.

A. God is superior.

B. I will not be able to fully \_\_\_\_\_ God.

Isa. 55:8,9 - “For My thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways My ways,” declares the Lord. <sup>9</sup> “As the heavens are higher than the earth, so are My ways higher than your ways and My thoughts than your thoughts. Job 38:2 - Who is this that obscures my plans with words without knowledge?”

C. God, the superior Creator, can be trusted with my life!

Psalm 90:2, “Before the mountains were born, Or you gave birth to the earth and the world, Even from everlasting to everlasting, you are God.”

Isa 43:1-3a - But now, this is what the Lord says— he who created you, Jacob, he who formed you, Israel: “Do not fear, for I have redeemed you; I have summoned you by name; you are mine. <sup>2</sup> When you pass through the waters, I will be with you; and when you pass through the rivers, they will not sweep over you. When you walk through the fire, you will not be burned; the flames will not set you ablaze. <sup>3</sup> For I am the Lord your God, the Holy One of Israel, your Savior...
