

KEEP CALM: THE LORD OF HOSTS IS WITH YOU!

I Sam. 1; I Sam. 17; Isaiah 2:10-12; II Sam. 5:10

“Lord of Hosts” is used well over _____ times in the OT! In Hebrew, it’s “Lord Sabaoth” – KJV translates as “LORD of hosts” He is the God of great strength and all ability. This Name associates God with _____. God is with us as our Warrior God. The NIV usually translates “Lord Almighty.” NASB: “God of Armies” The Message: “God of angel armies”

Psalm 24:7--10 Lift up your heads, you gates; be lifted up, you ancient doors, that the King of glory may come in. ⁸ Who is this King of glory? The Lord strong and mighty, the Lord mighty in battle. ⁹ Lift up your heads, you gates; lift them up, you ancient doors, that the King of glory may come in. ¹⁰ Who is he, this King of glory? The Lord Almighty— (KJV – the Lord of hosts) he is the King of glory.

Ps. 46:6,7: Nations are in uproar, kingdoms fall; he lifts his voice, the earth melts. ⁷ The Lord Almighty is with us; the God of Jacob is our fortress.

1 Sam 17:45 David said to the Philistine, You come against me with sword and spear and javelin, but I come against you in the name of the LORD Almighty, the God of the armies of Israel, whom you have defied. ⁴⁶ This day the LORD will hand you over to me, and I’ll strike you down and cut off your head.

Zechariah 4:6 'Not by might nor by power, but by My Spirit,' says the LORD of hosts.

III. THE LORD OF HOSTS WILL TRIUMPH OVER HIS ENEMIES

Isaiah 2:10-12 Go into the rocks, hide in the ground from the fearful presence of the Lord and the splendor of his majesty! ¹¹ The eyes of the arrogant will be humbled and human pride brought low; the Lord alone will be exalted in that day. ¹² The Lord Almighty has a day in store for all the proud and lofty, for all that is exalted (and they will be humbled)
