**I. I MUST KNOW THE \_\_\_\_\_**

If we are Bible people, we must interpret the events of the world from a Biblical perspective.

**A. We live in a rebellious world. vv. 1-3**

It is a malicious rebellion. They \_\_\_\_\_ - KJV

It is a strategic rebellion. They \_\_\_\_\_

It is stubborn rebellion. They take their stand.

It is a \_\_\_\_\_ rebellion. They take counsel together. - KJV

"The Message" – "Earth-leaders push for position, demagogues and delegates meet for summit talks."

We need \_\_\_\_\_ to function in our society. We need to understand that mankind is free only as we are under \_\_\_\_\_ authority. The goal of life is not to find your freedom – it's to choose the right Master!

**B. There is a sovereign \_\_\_\_\_ . vv. 4-5 – He is in charge!**

God is on the \_\_\_\_\_ Psalm 29:10 - "He sits as King forever."

**C. Christ is the victorious \_\_\_\_\_ . vv. 6-9**

Hebrews makes this clear that God is speaking to Jesus here.

There is coming a day when Christ will sit on the throne in Jerusalem (Zion)  
Rev. 11:15 – "The kingdoms of this world shall become the kingdoms of the Lord and of his Christ, and He shall reign forever and ever!"

v. 8 – how did the nations become Christ's inheritance? Through the \_\_\_\_\_!

**II. I MUST \_\_\_\_\_ THE LORD - vv. 10-11**

The heart of worship is not singing, but \_\_\_\_\_!

**III. I MUST KISS THE SON - v. 12a**

This is strange in our culture, but in that day, a kiss was a sign of \_\_\_\_\_;

**IV. I MUST – AND CAN - CLAIM MY \_\_\_\_\_ . v. 12b**

To experience God's approval because of our love for Him.

3 application steps:

**1. Pray.** 1 Timothy 2:1-2 says, "First of all pray for kings and all others who are in authority, that we may live a quiet and peaceful life."

**2. Trust.** Trust God in all situations.

**3. Support.** "Carry each other's burdens and fulfill the law of Christ."
