PROV. 24:19,20: NIV - ¹⁹⁾ Do not fret because of evildoers or be envious of the wicked, ²⁰ for the evildoer has no future hope, and the lamp of the wicked will be snuffed out.

I. COMMAND v. 9 - 13 Fret – to grow hot or angry - "in a"
II. WHEN YOU'RE IN A STEW: Ps. 37 A – v. 3 –Be confident in Him.
B. Do – v. 3 - deeds of moral good.
 C. Delight – v. 4 – find your joy in Him. Make Christ your focus The promise: "give you the desires of your heart:" 1) If you delight in God, your will be in harmony with His 2) God will put desires in your heart.
D
"way" – v. 5 – all of life - every part of our lives – this specifically means the things – the daily things. Prov. 3:6 – put Him first in the small things and He will direct the big things.
E. Rest $-v$. $7 - to be still/silent$.
F patiently – v. 7 In God's world, as well as TRUST is a factor.
G. – Reminder: don't fret – cease from frustration – v. 8
You can only do this as you have a right of God. Your attitude toward the situation you're in now is determined by your concept of God.

v. 37-40 - Consider the blameless, observe the upright; a future awaits those who seek peace. ³⁸ But all sinners will be destroyed; there will be no future for the wicked. ³⁹ The salvation of the righteous comes from the Lord; He is their stronghold in time of trouble. ⁴⁰ The Lord helps them and delivers them; He delivers them from the wicked and saves them, because they take refuge in Him.
