II Kings 6:8-23

Have you ever had the reaction of the servant? V. 15 – “Oh, no, my Lord!”
The next statement inevitably was “what shall we do?” When you wake up in a whole different world, make sure you ask the right _____ the right question!

Sometimes what we _____ do is more important than what we do.

Daniel 3:17,18 – “If we are thrown into the blazing furnace, the God we serve is able to deliver us from it, and He will deliver us...BUT EVEN IF HE DOES NOT, we want you to know...that we will not serve your gods or worship the image of gold you have set up.”

We need to know ahead of time what we _____ do.

II Chron. 20:15 - “Listen, King Jehoshaphat and all who live in Judah and Jerusalem! This is what the Lord says to you: ‘Do not be afraid or discouraged because of this vast army. For the battle is not yours, but God’s.’”

Luke 8:50 - “Don’t be afraid; just believe...”

It’s human nature to be afraid initially – it’s what you do _____!

2 sets of eyes: physical eyes and _____ eyes.

By the way, there are ALWAYS more with us!

The situation didn’t change – the servant’s _____ did.

Eph. 1:18-20 - ¹⁸I pray that the eyes of your heart may be enlightened in order that you may know the hope to which he has called you, the riches of his glorious inheritance in his holy people, ¹⁹and his incomparably great power for us who believe. That power is the same as the mighty strength ²⁰he exerted when he raised Christ from the dead...

II Cor. 4:16-18 - ¹⁶Therefore we do not lose heart. Though outwardly we are wasting away, yet inwardly we are being renewed day by day. ¹⁷For our light and momentary troubles are achieving for us an eternal glory that far outweighs them all. ¹⁸So we fix our eyes not on what is seen, but on what is unseen, since what is seen is temporary, but what is unseen is eternal.

Heb. 12:1-2 – “Let us run with perseverance the race marked out for us, fixing our eyes on Jesus, the pioneer and perfecter of our faith....v. 3 – Consider HIM....so that you will not grow weary and lose heart.”

What is faith? Heb. 11:1 – “confidence in what we hope for and assurance about what we do not see!” Faith is seeing with your _____ eyes: not that I’m getting what I want, but that God is with me regardless.
